AWARD TYPE:

The MPEA scholarship program provides individual scholarships for applicants who reside, work, volunteer, or attend school in the City of Meridian. Up to two of these scholarships will be awarded to current MPEA members or an MPEA member's immediate family member for \$750. An additional three scholarships will be awarded to members of the Meridian community for \$500.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Applicants must reside, work, volunteer, or attend school in the City of Meridian -OR- be or have an immediate family member who is a current member of the Meridian Police Employee Association (please make sure to note such on Page one of application).
- Applicants must plan on attending an accredited college or vocational education program in the Fall of 2020.
- Applicants must demonstrate evidence of leadership potential through community involvement, volunteerism, school activities, and/or work experience.

Neither person can be related to the applicant.
